<input type="checkbox"/> Indigo	Mature 4-6' tall. Fruit has chewier texture. Very sweet berry. Higher yield than Borealis or Tundra.
<input type="checkbox"/> Tundra	Mature 5-6' tall. Lower productivity. Good for fresh eating as well as baking and excellent berry for wine.
