The Morton County Soil Conservation District has established a scholarship opportunity for high school senior/college students that are residents of Morton County, North Dakota. The applicant(s) must be enrolled or currently pursuing a degree in an agricultural/natural resource management/environmental or related field at a two or four year accredited college or university. Multiple scholarships, each totaling up to \$500, may be awarded.

Interested applicants are required to complete the application form and compose an essay of no more than 500 words on **one** of the following topics chosen by the Morton County SCD. Essays should be typed. Applicants will need to maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and be a full time college student. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the recipient after the Morton County SCD Board receives the **Fall 2023** semester transcript from a 2yr/4yr accredited college or university.

Applications and essays are **due March 1st, 2023**. Essays will be judged by the Morton County SCD Board and staff and the winner will be notified no later than March 15th, 2023.
